

Modals of Necessity

Need (verb) (without to) is used in negative and interrogative sentences. Also, we can use don't have to / doesn't have to / didn't have to (past), must for the same purpose. In the affirmative, we use need to to express necessity.

Example Sentences

- He **mustn't** be late for the meeting.
- I **must** be careful not to upset her.
- They **must** leave immediately.
- You **don't have to** give me money but I can if you want.
- You **need to** do the exercises, they are obligatory.
- You **had to** try hard for the match.
- I **must** study next week.
