

Modals of Obligation

The main verbs of obligation are; **MUST**, **HAVE TO**, **SHOULD**. The past of have to / has to is had. Must is for personal obligations. Have to is for general obligations.

Example Sentences

- You **must** stop here.
- She looks sick. She **should** go home.
- I **must** do some work.
- You **shouldn't** have smoked.
- I **have to** return the book now.
- You **have to** wear a seatbelt when you drive.
