

Modals of Possibility

We use MAY, MIGHT and COULD to talk about present or future possibility. We can substitute may, might and could for maybe, perhaps or probably (which aren't modal verbs)

Example Sentences

- I might study math.
- I may pass math exam.
- I may eat dinner at 9:00 pm.
- Where is my watch? It could be in the my room.
- They could go to the party this afternoon.
- He could be lost.
- They could be there by now.
- Price can be high in Texas.
