

Phrasal Verbs For **CATCH**

Catch up (with sb)

to reach the same level or standard as sb or sth

- Western industry will not catch up with Japanese innovations

Catch on

to understand

- Wait a minute! I'm beginning to catch on.



Catch up on (sth)

to deal with a special activity to complete it.

- You have to catch up on your reading.

Catch (sb) up on (sth)

to give sb the latest news or information about sth

- Can someone catch us up on the latest news?

Catch out

to show that sb is doing wrong

- One day he caught her out when he found some letters she'd written.

Catch on

to become popular

- This game will catch on among young people.
