

Phrasal Verbs For **Check**

Check in

to register the arrival of
(passengers, etc)

- We will check in tomorrow.

Check up on

to obtain information about
sb/sth

- I called Richard every day to check up on him.

Check off

to mark with a tick

- Let's check off the names of the people to be invited.

Check back

to control again

- You should check back in an hour.

Check up

to investigate

- He was careful enough to check up every detail.

Check out

to leave a hotel after paying
and giving the room key

- When you check out, leave the room key at reception .
