Clear away

to take away sth to clear a place

- You should clear away all your toys before bedtime.

Clear out (of)

to leave a place

- She'll clear out of the house in two weeks.

Clear sb off

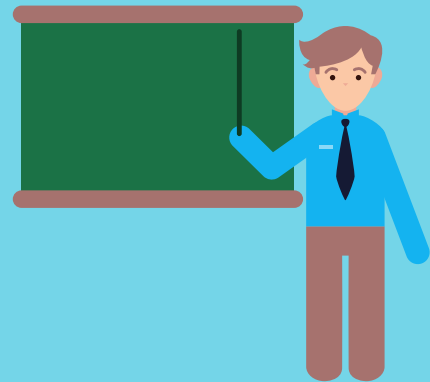
to make sb go away from a place

- The police'll use dogs to clear the protesters off the road.

Clear up

to solve or explain

- I think the trouble will clear up in a couple of days.



Clear up

to tidy

- Did you clear up your room before you went out?

Clear off

to go away

- The mist will clear off very soon.
