Cut into

to shortening into parts or to make sth smaller

 Knives easily cut into the cake.

Cut across

 If I cut across the field, it'll save time.

Cut through

to go through by cutting

 We cut through the solid rock to build the tunnel.

Cut up

to cut into pieces

 My mother cut up the onions and put them in the pot.

Cut out

to stop working

 There are two engines.
One of them cut out yesterday.

Cut down

to use less of sth

 I'm trying to cut down on sugar.
