## Cut back

to reduce

- The Government will cut back on defence spending.

## Cut in

to interrupt

- When you cut in on our conversation, we were talking.

## Cut into

to shortening into parts or to make sth smaller

- Knives easily cut into the cake.

## Cut across

to make a shorter route

- If I cut across the field, it'll save time.

## Cut through

to go through by cutting

- We cut through the solid rock to build the tunnel .

## Cut up

to cut into pieces

- My mother cut up the onions and put them in the pot.

## Cut out

to stop working

- There are two engines. One of them cut out yesterday.

## Cut down

to use less of sth

- I'm trying to cut down on sugar.
