

Phrasal Verbs with DRESS

Dress sb up

to give sb special clothes
to wear

- Her mother loves to dress her up.



Dress sb down

to scold

- The manager dressed them down in front of the whole school.

Dress down

to wear informal clothes

- In this office, employees always dress down on fridays.

Dress sth up

to make sth look better,
more attractive, etc.

- The jeweler dressed his gold up.

Dress up

to put on formal clothes
for a special occasion

- You don't need to dress up for the party.
