

# Phrasal Verbs For **KNOCK**

## **Knock around/about**

to spend a lot of time with sb

- I knocked around the weekend with my mates.

## **Knock off**

to stop working at the end of the day

- What time will they knock off?

## **Knock back**

to quickly drink sth

- We have knocked back two double rums.

## **Knock up**

to build or assemble sth quickly

- He knocked up a bed out of some old pieces of wood?

## **Knock over**

to hit sth/sb, to fall sth/sb down

Who knocked over the chair?

## **Knock together**

to make or to compose sth hastily

They knocked together two rough mailboxes with wooden boards.

## **Knock out**

to stop operating

The storm can knock out our electricity.

## **Knock down**

to strike to the ground with a blow

Bulldozers will knock down that shantytown.
