Set about

to begin doing something

- She set about studying.

Set forth

to start a journey

- They set forth on their travels in early June.

Set off

to initiate sth working

- Someone set off a fire extinguisher.

Set up

to place or to build sth

- The travelers set up a camp on the river bank.

Set to

to make sb feel sad

- When my work gets me down, I want to resign.

Set aside

to keep sth available for a purpose

- We set aside some money for repairs.

Set in

to take root, start and continue

- The rainy season has set in.

Set on/upon sb

to attack sb

- He was set on by a vicious dog.
