It means second of two things, people or animals.</p> <p>Example Sentences</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Did you see the other book that I bought? • Mary and Samuel are here, but where are the other kids? 	<p>Other is used with plural or uncountable noun. It means different, additional or extra. It is nonspecific.</p> <p>Example Sentences</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I want you to return the book I lent you the otherday. • Apple doesn't provide technical support for apps created by other developers.
