**Either... or** is a correlative conjunction.

We use **either ... or** for connect things which are the same types, phrases, clauses or words.



## Example Sentences

- Either Mark or Samuel will go.
- You can either come with me now or walk home.
- They don't have enough time. They can either have breakfast or have a shower.
- You can either call me at home or the office.
- He can have either tea or coffee.
- Mary didn't like either Madrid or Texas.
