“Even though” is used for the same meaning, expressing the idea of contrast. But structurally there is a small difference between them. We use this word to say that a thing is unusual or unexpected in relation to another thing.

Example Sentences

- Even though they were millionaires, they drive old cars.
- We are still very hungry, even though we ate very much .
- Even though she was very tired, she decided to go out.
- He had a good time with his family, even though he was very busy yesterday.
- I will always love, even though public opinion into the sea.
- Even though I had two hours to spare for shopping, I couldn't find the suit I wanted.
