

Using **in order to**

Especially while writing English, we can use the structure of “**in order to**” to declare our goal or purpose.

We can say that it is used to explain why an action is done. In this way, we connect two sentences each other.

Examples:

- I will do my best in order to teach you English.
- He got up early in order to catch the plane.
- In order to be rich, you must use your mind.
- I will go to England in order to improve my English.
- They met in order to get information from each other about the project.
- I went to shopping in order to buy a new jeans.
